SUBJECT: MEETING OF CALIFORNIA PHARMACEUTICAL ASSOC.

Following your guidelines in our discussion, we have prepared a statement on how pharmacists can fight drug abuse in their communities. The pharmacists in California have been waging a battle against Venereal disease and the number of cases has been reduced. I think you may want to mention this program as an example of what can be done when pharmacists are determined to educate and safeguard the public.

THE DRUG PROBLEM IN AMERICA TODAY IS NOT THE GOVERNMENT'S PROBLEM ALONE.

THE GOVERNMENT HAS AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN COMBATING THE SPREAD OF DRUG ABUSE.

IT MUST ENFORCE THE LAWS AGAINST THE PUSHERS.

IT MUST HELP PROVIDE THE REHABILITATION AND TREATMENT FACILITIES.

AND IT MUST MOVE TO HALT THE IMPORTATION OF DANGEROUS DRUGS.

BUT THE QUESTION I WANT TO ASK TODAY IS: WHAT ARE
THE PHARMACISTS GOING TO DO ABOUT THIS PROBLEM? WHAT CAN
YOU DO?

LET'S EXAMINE WHAT THE CANCER OF DRUG ABUSE MEANS

IN THE UNITED STATES:

- ---WE HAVE THE LARGEST POPULATION OF HEROIN ADDICTS

 IN THE WORLD -- OVER 330,000 AMERICANS ARE HARD CORE ADDICTS.
- ---FIVE TO SIX TONS OF HEROIN ARE CONSUMED EACH YEAR
 IN THE UNITED STATES.
- ---THE HUMAN AND PROPERTY COSTS ARE TREMENDOUS,
 OVER \$25 MILLION A DAY IS STOLEN BY ADDICTS.
- ---50 PERCENT OF ALL METROPOLITAN CRIMES ARE DRUG
 RELATED.
- ---THERE'S BEEN A 322 PERCENT INCREASE IN NARCOTICS
 ARRESTS SINCE 1970.
- ---LAST YEAR, MORE YOUNG PEOPLE DIED OF DRUG ABUSE
 THAN WERE KILLED IN VIETNAM.

IT'S CLEAR THAT DRUG ABUSE MEANS MORE THAN HEROIN

ADDICTION. IT MEANS THE OVERUSE OF ALL TYPES OF DRUGS AND

MEDICINES.

ABOUT MARIJUANA. NOT MAKING DECISIONS ON ITS LEGALIZATION
UNTIL THE FACTS ARE FIRMLY ESTABLISHED AS TO THE POTENTIAL
HARM OF THIS DRUG. WE DON'T KNOW WHAT ITS EFFECTS ARE, AND
I'M NOT ABOUT TO EQUATE IT WITH ALCOHOL UNTIL MORE RESEARCH
IS DONE.

I BELIEVE PHARMACISTS HAVE AN IMPORTANT ROLE TO PLAY
IN HALTING DRUG ABUSE.

AS PROFESSIONAL MEN, AND AS COMMUNITY LEADERS, YOU
MUST TAKE AN ACTIVE PART IN SOLVING THIS PROBLEM THAT REACHES

INTO EVERY AMERICAN FAMILY.

AND YOU MUST PLACE PRESSURE ON THE PHARMACEUTICAL

COMPANIES TO HALT THE OVERPRODUCTION OF BARBITUATES AND

AMPHETAMINES.

EVERY PHARMACIST MUST STAND AGAINST THE PROMISCUOUS DISPENSING OF DRUGS.

AS COMMUNITY LEADERS, YOU HAVE AN OBLIGATION TO GO

INTO THE SCHOOLS AND EDUCATE CHILDREN ABOUT DRUGS.

YOU HAVE AN OBLIGATION TO TALK TO THE PARENTS AND TO HELP PLAN CITIZEN DRUG CONTROL STRATEGIES AND PROGRAMS.

YOU'RE THE ONES WHO CAN TALK TO THE JUDGES AND LOCAL OFFICIALS ABOUT THE COMMUNITY'S DRUG PROBLEM.

AND PHARMACISTS ARE THE ONES THAT MUST TAKE A LEAD

IN ESTABLISHING COMMUNITY REHABILITATION AND INFORMATION

CENTERS.

I KNOW DRUG ABUSE IS A TOUGH PROBLEM. BUT WE CAN LICK IT.

WE MUST BOLSTER FEDERAL SPENDING FOR DRUG RELATED

LAW ENFORCEMENT AND FOR REHABILITATION FACILITIES.

WE MUST ESTABLISH A FEDERAL DRUG CURE AND CENTRAL AGENCY TO COORDINATE ALL OF THE GOVERNMENT'S ANTI-DRUG EFFORTS UNDER ONE ROOF.

AND WE MUST MOVE TO HALT THE IMPORTATION OF HEROIN

INTO THIS NATION. IF THE CIA CAN FIND SPIES, THEY CAN

LOCATE AND TRACK DOWN AN INTERNATIONAL NARCOTICS RING.

BUT THE BATTLE AGAINST DRUG ABUSE WON'T BE WON IN WASHINGTON, D.C. IT MUST BE FOUGHT AND WON ON THE STREET WHERE YOU LIVE, IN YOUR COMMUNITIES AND NEIGHBORHOODS.

I ASK YOU TO JOIN WITH ME IN BRINGING OUR MARIJUANA,
OUR HEROIN, OUR L S D PROBLEMS, UNDER CONTROL.
