THE FUTURE HOLDS GREAT HOPES FOR ALL OF US

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BUT AS WE CAN SEE, AN UNCONTROLLED, UNPLANNED FUTURE COULD
BE A REAL MENACE TO AMERICAN LIFE.

FAR TOO FEW AMERICANS HAVE STOPPED TO THINK HOW THEIR
BASIC AND FUNDAMENTAL FREEDOM OF CHOICE IS THREATENED NOW BY
FORCES THEY DO NOT CONTROL.

WHERE YOU WANT TO LIVE, HOW YOU WANT TO LIVE, WHO YOU
WANT TO LIVE NEAR, HOW YOU WANT TO EARN A LIVING, WHERE YOU
WANT TO WORK, WHERE YOU SPEND YOUR FREE TIME AND VACATIONS,
WHERE YOUR CHILDREN GO TO COLLEGE, ARE THE TYPES OF DECISIONS
WHICH YOU ARE SUPPOSED TO MAKE.

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BUT IN REALITY, MANY OF THESE DECISIONS ARE MADE FOR US
TODAY BY CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND OUR CONTROL -- AS WE SAY, "BY
THE FORCES OF MODERN SOCIETY."

I BELIEVE A PERSON'S ESSENTIAL FREEDOM OF CHOICE MUST BE
PRESERVED AND PROTECTED NOT ONLY FROM THOSE WHO MAY WANT TO
IMPOSE THEIR WILL ON OURS, BUT FROM THE UNCHARTED FUTURE WHICH
MAY FORCE US TO LIVE A CERTAIN WAY NOT TO OUR LIKING.

OUR ENVIRONMENT, OUR SYSTEM OF GOVERNMENT, OUR ECONOMY,
OUR HEALTH, OUR CITIES, OUR FAMILIES, AND OUR INDIVIDUAL
FREEDOM ARE THREATENED UNLESS WE TAKE ACTION TO
PLAN THE FUTURE.

WHAT MUST WE DO?

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THERE ARE, OF COURSE, NO EASY ANSWERS. NO SET FORMULAE
EXIST. AND THERE IS NO ONE PLAN THAT CAN ACHIEVE THIS GOAL.

BUT WE MUST BEGIN.

WE MUST CHOOSE THE COURSE OF PLANNING AND DESIGNING OUR
FUTURE, OF UNDERSTANDING GROWTH, OF CONTROLLING IT, OF GUIDING
THE UTILIZATION AND ALLOCATION OF OUR RESOURCES TO MAKE OUR
INSTITUTIONS RESPOND TO THE KIND OF FUTURE WE AS GOOD PEOPLE
WANT.

THIS IS THE COURSE OF BALANCED NATIONAL GROWTH AND
DEVELOPMENT.

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✓ BALANCED NATIONAL GROWTH MEANS THINKING ABOUT THE FUTURE
TODAY. ✓ IT MEANS TAKING STOCK OF OUR COUNTRY. ✓ IT MEANS COORDINATING
AND REFORMING OUR INSTITUTIONS. ✓ IT MEANS POSITIVE POPULATION
DISTRIBUTION POLICIES.

✓ BALANCED GROWTH MEANS FOCUS ON REBUILDING THE NEIGHBORHOOD
-- ON THE STREET WHERE PEOPLE LIVE, AND, HELPING PEOPLE WHO
LIVE THERE TO CHANGE THINGS AS THEY WANT THEM CHANGED.

I WILL SOON INTRODUCE IN THE CONGRESS THE BALANCED
NATIONAL GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1972.

THIS BILL IS THE FIRST STEP TOWARDS THINKING ABOUT THE
FUTURE TODAY. IT WILL PROVIDE THE MECHANISMS TO HARNESS THE
ENERGY, THE TALENT, THE INTELLECT OF THE BEST MINDS IN OUR
COUNTRY, SO THAT WE CAN DETERMINE HOW WE ARE GOING TO LIVE,
WHERE THIS NATION IS GOING, AND HOW IT IS GOING TO GET THERE.

THIS LEGISLATION IS PROBLEM ORIENTED. IT IS NO IVORY TOWER
EXERCISE. IT WILL ALLOW US TO ADDRESS OURSELVES TO THE FUTURE
-- TO ASSESS THE EFFECT OF PRESENT PROGRAMS ON TOMORROW'S
NEEDS, AND BRING THE GROWTH OF THIS NATION INTO MANAGEABLE,
UNDERSTANDABLE FORM.

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THE BALANCED NATIONAL GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1972
WILL PROVIDE THE TOOLS NECESSARY FOR US TO MAKE RATIONAL PROGRAM
CHOICES TODAY, SO THAT PROBLEMS DO NOT BECOME IMPOSSIBLE TO
SOLVE TOMORROW.

THE LEGISLATION WILL HELP BALANCE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL
GROWTH IN URBAN AND RURAL AREAS. IT WILL REQUIRE FEDERAL
AGENCIES TO ASK QUESTIONS ABOUT PROGRAMS THAT HAVE NEVER BEEN
ASKED BEFORE. IT WILL REQUIRE AGENCIES TO THINK ABOUT THE
IMPACT OF PROGRAMS ON PEOPLE AND ON THEIR LIVES -- NOT JUST
TODAY, BUT IN THE NEXT FIVE, TEN, AND FIFTY YEARS.

IMPORTANT TO BE LEFT TO A SMALL MINORITY OF OUR POPULATION WHO

RUN THE GOVERNMENT.

THE FUTURE MEANS NOT ONLY WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO A GREAT
COUNTRY AS A WHOLE, BUT WHAT WILL HAPPEN IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD
AND TO YOUR FAMILY.

Partnership

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L THE JOB OF CHARTING THE FUTURE OF AMERICA MUST BE THE WORK
OF A PARTNERSHIP OF GOVERNMENT AND THE PEOPLE.

AND THIS IS WHERE THE JAYCEES PLAY AN IMPORTANT ROLE.

L AS COMMUNITY LEADERS YOU ARE ON THE FRONT LINE OF THE
FUTURE WORKING DAILY TO BUILD A BETTER AMERICA.

L YOUR LEADERSHIP IN THE CITIES AND TOWNS OF THIS NATION
MUST PROVIDE THE TYPE OF GUIDANCE IN SHAPING REALISTIC

ALTERNATIVES FOR FUTURE GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT DESIGNED FOR THE
PEOPLE -- NOT FOR EXPEDIENCY AS WE TOO OFTEN HAVE DONE IN THE
PAST.

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IF PEOPLE ARE THE VICTIMS OF UNPLANNED, UNCOORDINATED GROWTH BECAUSE THEY HAVE NO ROLE TO PLAY IN DETERMINING THEIR FUTURES, THE ALIENATION, FRUSTRATION AND CYNICISM WE SEE EVERY DAY WILL GROW.

BUT NO AMOUNT OF EFFORT AT THE NEIGHBORHOOD AND COMMUNITY LEVEL CAN OVERCOME THE HURDLE OF NATIONAL LEADERSHIP WITHOUT A VISION OF THE FUTURE AND THE DESIRE TO WORK TOWARD SOLVING OUR PROBLEMS.

I SEEK THE PRESIDENCY BECAUSE I BELIEVE GUIDING THE GROWTH OF OUR NATION IS NOT AN UNSURMOUNTABLE OBSTACLE.

I HAVE HEARD THE VOICES OF THOSE WHO SAY IT CANNOT BE DONE.

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THESE ARE THE VOICES OF THOSE WHO LIVE IN THE PAST AND WANT
OTHERS TO DO SO.

THEY ARE FALSE VOICES. THEY WOULD RATHER SAY "NO" AND GIVE
A THOUSAND REASONS WHY NOT THAN TO SAY "YES" AND GIVE ONE REASON
WHY.

OUR PROBLEMS WILL BE SOLVED BECAUSE REASON, UNDERSTANDING,
RESOURCES, AND THE COMMITMENT OF PEOPLE WERE APPLIED TO THEM.

THE FUTURE OF THIS COUNTRY CAN BE SHAPED. WE CAN HAVE
POLICIES WHICH CONTROL OUR FUTURE AND PLAN OUR GROWTH BECAUSE
AMERICANS HAVE AGREED THAT THINGS IN THIS NATION CAN BE BETTER,
THAT CONDITIONS OF LIFE CAN IMPROVE, AND THAT MAN CAN SHAPE
HIS LIFE AS WELL AS REACT TO IT.

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THIS IS WHAT I WANT TO HELP OUR NATION ACHIEVE.

THIS IS WHY I SEEK THE PRESIDENCY.

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
