SENATOR HUMPHREY'S MESSAGE TO HARRISBURG, AFL-CIO MEETING September 8, 1972

When you clear away all the political rhetoric, this election is not just a battle between McGovern and Nixon. The question is: Do you want a Republican President and a Republican Congress whose political bedfellows are big business and the corporate special interests -- or a Democratic President and a Democratic Congress who have a demonstrated record of fighting for the working people? The issues are clear. Do you want special tax privilege for the few and the rich -- or tax justice for all? Do you want ever increasing corporate salaries and corporate profits for the few and wage controls for the many -- or do you want fair play, fair prices, and take home pay that will provide for you and your family? I think you know the answer. You owe it to yourself and your families to vote the Democratic ticket.
