THE NIXON ADMINISTRATION OF "TRYING TO POSE AS

THE FRIEND OF THE WORKING FAMILY, WHILE CUTTING THE HEART OUT

OF PROGRAMS THAT BENEFIT WORKING AMERICANS."

SPEAKING TO A UNI-LAM LEGISLATIVE CONFEREN

"WHEN WORKING PEOPLE

CLOSELY AT THE PRESIDENT'S BUDGET, THEY WILL SEE THEIR PT

NEEDS ARE GIVEN SHORT SHRIFT."

"OUT OF A \$268.7 BILLION BUDGET, LESS THAN TWO PERCEN

OF THE BUDGET GOES FOR URBAN HOUSING.

LITTLE MORE THAN ONE PERCENT OF THE BUDGET GOES FOR

THE HEALTH CARE OF MORE THAN 150 MILLION AMERICANS WHO ARE

NEITHER OLD NOR POOR -- ABOUT \$20 PER PERSON PER YEAR.

LESS THAN ONE PERCENT OF THE BUDGET GOES TO COMBAT THE

CRITICAL PROBLEM OF CRIME, INCLUDING DRUG AGUSE.

"LESS THAN ONE HALF OF ONE PERCENT OF THE BUDGET GOES

FOR MASS TRANSIT -- THE KEY TO TRAFFIC CONGESTION AND AIR AND

NOISE POLLUTION.

"THESE ARE FOUR AREAS THAT TYPIFY THE PROBLEMS WORKING
FAMILIES WANT GOVERNMENT TO LOS JUMPHREY OBSTRUCT

LESS THAN FIVE PERCENT OF THE PRESIDENT'S BUDGET IS ALLOCATED

TO ALL OF THEM COMBINED.

"WORKING PEOPLE KNOW THAT THE REPUBLICAN PARTY HAS

TRADITIONALLY OPPOSED MEDICARE, AID TO EDUCATION, AND LOWER

INTEREST RATES TO HOME-BUYERS. THIS BUDGET IS JUST MORE OF

THE SAME."

HUMPHREY MAINTAINED THAT THE PRESIDENT'S ATTEMPT TO POSE

AS A FRIEND OF THE WORKER, WHILE ENACTING POLICIES AGAINST

WORKERS' INTERESTS, AMOUNT TO DECEPTION

"THE PRESIDENT DOES NOT LEVEL WITH YOU." HE TOLD THE

CONFERENCE. "HE TELLS YOU THAT HE IS CUTTING SPENDING, BECAUSE

IT IS THE ONLY WAY TO CONTROL INFLATION. BUT HE IS NOT CONTROLLING

INFLATION.

"GROCERY COSTS ARE HIGHER. MEDICAL COSTS ARE HIGHER,

RENTS ARE HIGHER, GASOLINE IS HIGHER. ONLY PROGRAMS FOR

PEOPLE -- AND THE RATE OF WAGE INCREASES ARE LOWER.

"THE PRESIDENT TELLS YOU HE IS RETURNING 'POWER TO THE PEOPLE.' BUT THE PRESIDENT'S POLICY, AS REVEALED IN HIS BUDGET, IS NOT TO RETURN POWER TO THE PEOPLE. IT IS TO RETURN PROBLEMS OF NATIONAL SCOPE BACK TO STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS WHICH HAVE INADEQUATE RESOURCES TO SOLVE THEM. "THE PRESIDENT TELLS YOU THAT HE IS DETERMINED NOT TO HAVE A TAX INCREASE AT THE FEDERAL LEVEL. SO HE SHOVES PROBLEMS BACK TO STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT WHERE THEY'RE EITHER TO BE IGNORED OR YOUR PROPERTY TAXES WILL HAVE TO BE RAISED TO

PAY THE BILLS."

HUMPDREY ASSERTED THAT THE PRESIDENT, IN CUTTING BACK

PROGRAMS, IS ACTING "TRUE TO REPUBLICAN FORM - LIKE A CORPOR-

ATION PRESIDENT WHO CUTS BACK WAGES AND BENEFITS BECAUSE HIS

OWN MISMANAGEMENTS THREATEN TO CUT INTO HIS PROFITS.

"THE ADMINISTRATION HAS MISMANAGED THE ECONOMY FOR FOUR

YEARS, TO THE TUNE OF \$100 BILLION IN DEFICITS, SO IT DECIDES

THAT PROGRAMS WHICH BENEFIT PEOPLE MUST BE CUT BACK," HE SAID.

"THE ADMINISTRATION IMPOUNDS FUNDS. IT TERMINATES PROGRAMS.

ITS ADVISERS HIDE FROM THE CONGRESS BEHIND EXECUTIVE PRIVILEGE.

ITS BUDGET IS DEVELOPED BEHIND CLOSED DOORS.

THE ADMINISTRATION'S BIG-BUSINESS MENTALITY
ALSO SHAPES THE WAY IN WHICH THE
BUDGET IS PUT TOGETHER, AS WELL AS ITS
SUBSTANCE.

THE FORMER VICE PRESIDENT CHARGED THAT ALL OF THESE

ACTIONS RESULT FROM THE ADMINISTRATION'S DISTRUST OF THE

ABILITY OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE, REPRESENTED BY CONGRESS, TO

SET THEIR OWN NATIONAL PRIORITIES.

"THE ATTEMPT TO DISMANTLE PROGRAMS THAT BENEFIT PEOPLE -
AND TO DO IT IN A WAY THAT IGNORES THE PEOPLE'S REPRESENTATIVES,

IS WHAT THE CONSTITUTIONAL CRISIS IS ALL ABOUT, "HUMPHREY

CONCLUDED."

"IF THE PRESIDENT IS SERIOUS ABOUT DECENTRALIZING POWER,

HE SHOULD START BY RESTORING THE BALANCE OF POWER BETWEEN

THE AMOUNT US BUREAUCRATS OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH AND THE

PEOPLE'S ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES IN CONGRESS."

HUMPHREY STATED THAT CONGRESS SHOULD SET IT.

"Congress should also set up an Office of Budget Analysis

AND PROGRAM EVALUATION, SO IT CAN ESTABLISH BUDGET PRIORITIES

AND EVALUATE PROGRAMS, " HE SAID:

SPECULATING ON THE POLITICAL STRATEGY BEHIND THE PRESIDENT'S

15 TRANSPARENT,
BUDGET THE SENATOR COMMENTED, "PRESIDENT NIXON KNOWS THAT IF

YOU ADD UP THE ELDERLY, THE DISABLED, THE MENTALLY ILL, THE

POOR FARMERS, THE CHILDREN AND MOTHERS ON WELFARE, THE

STRUGGLING STUDENTS, AND OTHERS NEEDING HELP, YOU DO NOT GET

A POLITICAL MAJORITY.

"THE PRESIDENT SEEMS TO BELIEVE THE AMERICAN MAJORITY

HAS GROWN INDIFFERENT TOWARD THOSE WHO LEGITIMATELY NEED

HELP, AS THEIR OWN STANDARD OF LIVING HAS RISEN OVER THE YEARS

"HE IS DEAD WRONG ABOUT THIS AND HIS MISCALCULATION ON

THE POINT MEANS HE WILL NOT SUGGEED IN FASHIONING A POLITICAL

MAJORITY OF HAVES VERSUS HAVE NOTS.

"HE IS WRONG BECAUSE HE FORGETS THAT WE HAVE SOMEONE
IN OUR FAMILY WHO ARE AMONG THE MILLIONS OF PEOPLE IN THIS
NATION WHO CANNOT BE SELF-RELIANT WITHOUT SOME HELP."

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
