COMMUNITIES NEEDED THESE PARTICULAR THINGS. THE PLAIN FACT IS, THOUGH, THAT MANY SOCIAL AND PUBLIC SERVICE PROGRAMS HAVE BEEN LEFT OUT. The Tederal Cert books have crippled many constructive efforts WE MUST ASK OURSELVES WHY. WE KNOW THE FAULTS OF MANY OF THESE PROGRAMS: SOME ARE TOO DIVISIVE -- SOME HAVE SET THE "HAVE LITTLES" AGAINST THE "HAVE NOTS" -- SOME HAVE BEEN MISMANAGED OR HAVE PRODUCED MEAGER RESULTS. BUT WE ALSO KNOW THAT THERE HAVE BEEN MANY SUCCESSES --PEOPLE WHO NEVER HAD A JOB OR ANY KIND OF TRAINING NOW HAD OPPORTUNITY -- ELDERLY HAVE ACTIVITY CENTERS -- YOUNG CHILDREN HAVE DAY-CARE CENTERS AND HEADSTART.
