WATERGATE IS A NATIONAL TRAGEDY.

LIT IS A TRAGEDY BECAUSE THE TRUST AND FAITH THAT THE AMERICAN PEOPLE PLACED IN ITS HIGHEST ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS WAS MISUSED.

IT IS A TRAGEDY BECAUSE SOME HIGH OFFICIALS CONFENIENTLY FORGOT THAT THE WHOLE PURPOSE OF CONSTITUTIONAL GOVERNMENT IS TO SERVE THE PEOPLE. IT IS A TRAGEDY BECAUSE THEY PERVERTED THE CONSTITUTION.
