I AM A MAN WHO ENJOYS LIFE, THERE ARE FAR, AR MORE THINGS
THAT I SHOULD LIKE TO DO TO EXPERIENCE TO ACCOMPLISH, THAN I
SHALL EVER HAVE TIME FOR PUBLIC SERVICE—TO WHICH I AM DEVOTED—
DENIES A MAN AS MUCH, CERTAINLY, AS IT GIVES TO HIM. THE DEMANDS
OF THIS LIFE ARE INSATIABLE: THERE ARE NEVER ENOUGH HOURS IN THE
DAY, DAYS IN THE WEEK, CHILDREN GROW UP BEFORE ONE REALIZES HOW
TIME HAS FLOWN BY. OFTEN THE FEELS FRUSTRATED BY THE SHEER
