NEVER BEFORE HAS THE NEED FOR GLOBAL ECONOMIC INTERDEPENDENCE BEEN GREATER, AND NEVER BEFORE HAS THE POLITICAL ATMOSPHERE NEEDED TO ACHIEVE THIS GOAL BEEN WORSE. THIS IS THE IRONY OF THE PRESENT SITUATION, THE UNITED STATES MADE VERY FAR REACHING PROPOSALS BEFORE THE RECENTLY CONCLUDED SEVENTH SPECIAL SESSION OF THE UNITED NATIONS. OUR POSITION WAS ONE THAT WAS SUPPORTED BY DELEGATES FROM THE IT RECOGNIZED INDUSTRIALIZED AND DEVELOPING THE URGENT NEED FOR A COORDINATED APPROACH ON SUCH Issues as resource transfer, agricultural develop-MENT, COMMODITY AGREEMENTS, AND AN EQUITABLE RE-

STRUCTURING OF THE U.N.

BUT PROGRESS MADE AT THIS SPECIAL SESSION HAS BEEN ERODED BY THE RECENT GENERAL ASSEMBLY VOTE THE UNITED NATIONS IS A WORLD PARLIAMENT, ON LIONISM. IT IS A POLITICAL AND LEGISLATIVE INSTITUTION, WORKING TOGETHER ON GLOBAL ECONOMIC PROBLEMS WITHIN THIS FORUM REQUIRES MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING AND COOPERATION. THIS TYPE OF ATMOSPHERE IS DIFFICULT TO ACHIEVE WHEN POLITICAL HOSTILITY AMONG MEMBER STATES IS INTENSIFIED BY RESOLUTIONS SUCH

AS THE ONE PASSED LAST WEEK.

Such an atmosphere is detrimental to formulating SOLUTIONS TO THE WORLD'S ECONOMIC PROBLEMS. THE NATIONS OF THE DEVELOPING WORLD MUST UNDERSTAND THAT THEY CANNOT CONTINUE TO ATTACK THE INDUSTRIALIZED NATIONS ON THE POLITICAL FRONT AND DEMAND FUNDAMENTAL CHANGES AND CONCESSIONS ON THE ECONOMIC FRONT Far too much is at stake to permit the SITUATION AT THE UNITED NATIONS TO DETERIORATE FURTHER THE U.N. SYSTEM ITSELF MAY BE IMPERILED. AN EQUITABLE RESTRUCTURING OF THE WORLD'S ECONOMY IS NOT ONLY A HUMANITARIAN OBJECTIVE. ULTIMATELY, THE PROSPERITY OF ALL NATIONS DEPENDS ON FINDING SOLUTIONS TO THE GROWING PROBLEMS OF HUNGER, UNEMPLOYMENT, INFLATION AND OVERPOPULATION.
