

REMARKS OF SENATOR HUBERT H. HUMPHREY
FUNDRAISER FOR CONGRESSMAN WILLIAM J. GREEN

Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania

September 23, 1976

I have come to Pittsburgh tonight to tell my friends in the labor movement that they need a strong Democratic voice in the United States Senate.

They need someone who cares about their problems.

They need someone who will listen to them.

They need someone who will fight battles for them.

That man, that strong voice is Congressman Bill Green.

When no one in the House was willing to take on the big oil lobby, Bill Green stepped forward and slew the giant. This man was the author of the amendment which killed the oil depletion allowance for the giant oil companies.

We had been working on this repeal for years. And Bill Green was able to win because he's a fighter.

Because of what he has done, tax dollars from the oil companies now go to the Treasury instead of staying in the pockets of some of the largest corporations in the world.

The labor movement and the Democratic Party always have believed that no challenge is too great for the American nation.

Therefore, we must muster our strength, our courage, our imagination, our great energy. We can become whatever we want to be.

America is a young country with its future before it. The American people are builders. They are restless. They are energetic. They are idealists who want to put their ideals to the test.

America looks to new leaders who can make our country both dynamic and just. It looks to the Bill Greens, the Jimmy Carters, and the Walter Mondales. These men have a sense of compassion, but also a dedication to individual initiative. These leaders can inspire and are inspired by our history, but they sense that our greatness is in the future.

With hard work and your help, America's best days -- America's great days -- have only just begun.
