Kelly Confesses His Crime.

Montreal, April 20.—Joseph E. Kelly confessed to-day to the murder of Cashier Stickney at Somersworth, N. H. He admitted that he committed both the murder and the robbery, and says he had no accomplices. He vehemently insisted, however, that he had no intention of killing the cashier, but that he had to do it because the old gentleman recognized him.
