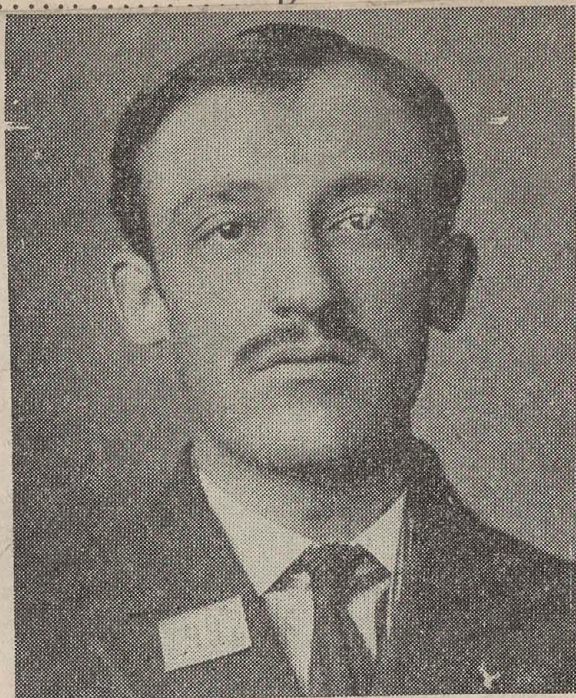

Also arrested March 1, 1914, by Bergin and Rourke, False Pretense, fined \$100 and costs and 30

days W. H. on each of the two charges. He is a fake prize fight and wrestling match promoter, and while apparently engaged in carrying out details of some match, he uses that as a blind to pass bad checks.
